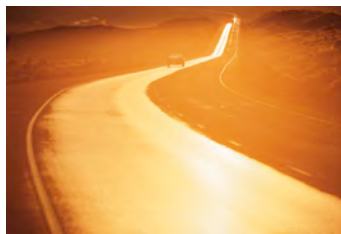

This is one of only two centers in the US devoted to tick born diseases!
