We also need someone to take over the activity list. Ruth Ann Keen will no longer be doing it.

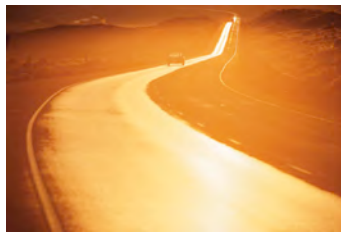
Don't forget about all the events going on through out the month – cards, darts, casino and shopping trips and different plays. Check out the activity list for all the details.
