Bet ya didn't know that the term "dementia" is a catchall word that clumps 14 diseases together! The specific disease tells you what to expect so it's an important thing to know. There are resources to help caregivers. ADRC in each county, the Memory Cafe which includes spouses, Pastime Adult Daycare in Minocqua. If you hire a private caregiver be sure they are a registered caregiver. The Alzheimers Association has 24 hour social workers on call that you can talk with. Concerned about a loved one? Call Adult Protective Care Services. If finances are a big concern but you need a break, Pastime has a scholarship program!!! Pastime need volunteers!! The program is only Tuesday and Thursday from 9-2:30. You don't need to volunteer every day or even a full day. Part time volunteers are welcome.
