What: Picnic Gathering & Annual Meeting on Wed, August 5, 2020

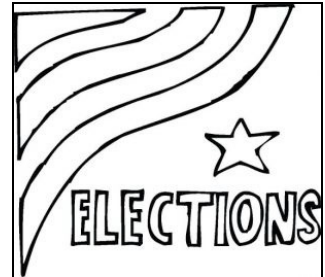
Where: St Germain Park - Large Shelter
