What You Missed at the February Meeting (besides seeing everyone)

Heather Schallock, Nicolet College Foundation Executive Director, had some interesting facts about the Nicolet College. It is a 2 yr college, 94% of it's graduates are employed within 6 months of graduation and 3/4 of those stay in the Nicolet district! Of the 1600 students enrolled annually 87% are part time, 73% are age 29 and under and 63% are females.

300 scholarships are awarded each year totaling \$250,000 to \$300,000. Technical programs cost \$150/credit while University transfer programs are \$200/credit. Isaac Vetter from Sayner is the current PrimeTimers scholarship recipient. He is enrolled in the Automotive program. Thank you Barb for taking notes for me.
