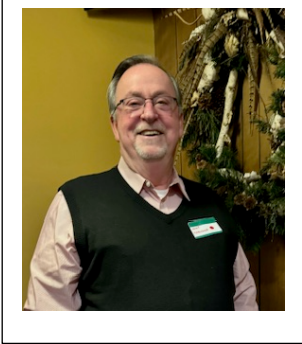

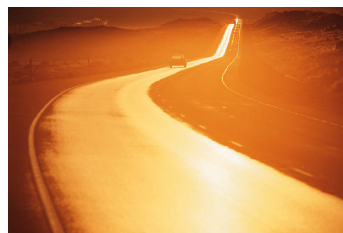


As our mild winter continues, I hope this message finds you all doing well. Just a week or so from when you receive this newsletter it will be Spring. No Really.

**Update from Don Colton about the Chicago trip in July**

Update on 7/31-8/3 Chicago trip: The museum at Cable WI has just raised its ASTC cost from \$30 to \$100. So... our ASTC museum passes will be purchased elsewhere, from the Neville Museum in Green Bay. Its rates are \$45 for an individual, \$60 for two adults and \$75 for a family including spouse, two children/grandchildren under 18. Since an ASTC pass is valid only for museums that are more than 90 miles away from both the membership museum and your ID residence, the Oshkosh EAA Museum is dropped from our itinerary because it's within 90 miles of Green Bay. On the other hand, as a bonus, the Neville membership also includes a "Time Traveler" pass that covers many additional nationwide museums (like 13 in Wisc).

The basic cost remains the same (\$430 per adult, \$235 per child, plus ASTC). Our bus is half-filled. To assure a place please make your fully refundable \$100pp deposit by MARCH 21.
