Thanks to Fred Radtke, Richard Leurquin, Bob Butzer, and Jim Upthegrove for taking down the Christmas decorations.

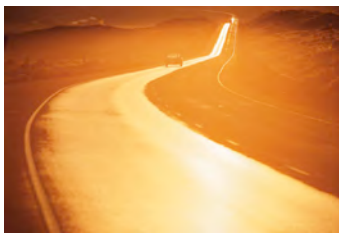
A motion was made and passed to donate \$1,000 to St. Germain Elementary School for fencing around the garden behind the school.

IMPORTANT: When Writing Checks for PrimeTimer activities

There are times when it's more convenient to write a check rather than use cash to pay for something. However, when writing a check to pay for a PrimeTimer event or activity there are a couple of things we would like you to keep in mind.

- ◆ Please **do not use one check** to pay for multiple events or activities. (I.e., the van is always considered one activity and the play or concert is a SEPARATE activity)
- ◆ **Do not include your dues payment in a check that covers other things.** (Please write one check for your dues and then separate checks for each of the other things.)
- ◆ Please pay cash for your van rides. If you're writing a check for your ticket to a performance for instance, do not include the cost of the van in that check.

While you might grumble about having to write separate checks, but this makes it easier on the event organizer and our treasurer (each activity has a separate category for the treasurer)

In addition, when writing a check to pay for a PrimeTimer event or activity please be sure to verify whom the check should be made payable to. When we go to performances at local venues, the person organizing that activity has often purchased the tickets themselves. Therefore any check should be made payable to that person. But then again, sometimes tickets are purchased through the PrimeTimers treasurer. So please ask what name goes on the check. The name of each activity organizer is listed on the activity list in each newsletter.
