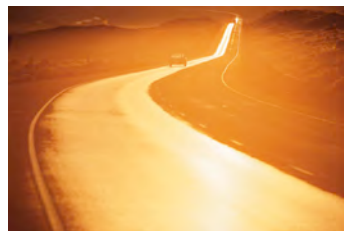

This six-mile portage allowed goods from the Atlantic to reach the Great Lakes. When combined with the portage at Portage WI, linking the Fox and Wisconsin Rivers, goods could travel thousands of inland miles more. Ft.
