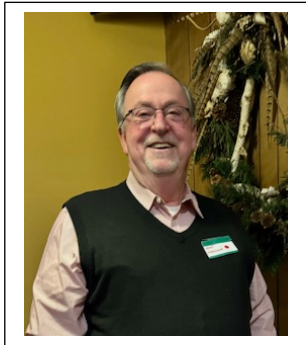

From Fred:

There are some upcoming May activities that are planned that we need to buy a ticket for reserve seating. There will be sign-up sheets at the May 1st PrimeTimers meeting. If you don't make the May 1st meeting but may still want to join us at any of these events, see info below:

The following are trips planned that don't need reservations, but you need to sign-up to go:

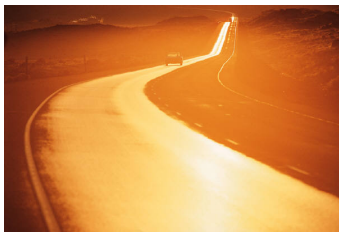
