Soon our snowbirds will be leaving, and we've had some members move - so wherever you are please have a safe winter!

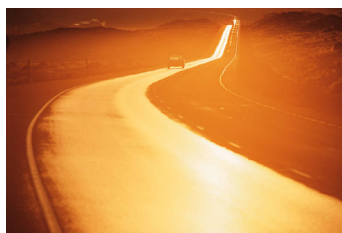
