The Campanile Center has informed us that they've put a cap on all of their performances. None will cost more than \$25.

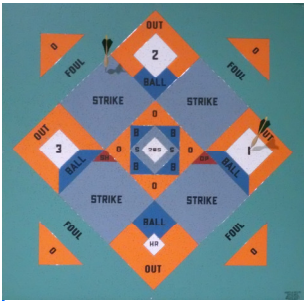

WE NEED A LITTLE HELP HERE

Without an available driver the Transportation Coordinator will be unable to schedule a bus from NorthWoods Transit. That means the event will have to be cancelled. If you can drive a SUV, you can drive the bus, no special licensing is required. We will give you training so that you're comfortable with the bus. 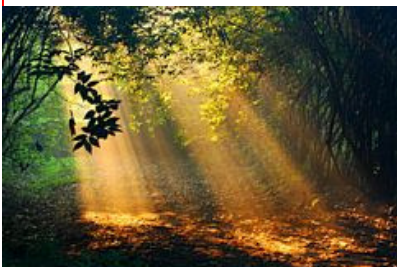
