The museum is known for its internationally acclaimed *Birds in Art* exhibition. All-new-avian-themed interpretations in original paintings, sculptures, and graphics are sure to inspire in endless ways. It is also a 2017 winner of the National Medal for Museum and Library Service and the 2016 Wisconsin Governor's Arts, Culture and Heritage Tourism Award. We will be visiting the Birds in Art Exhibit at the museum, the Black Bear Education Center, and possibly Timms Hills, the highest point in Wisconsin - elevation 1951.5 ft.



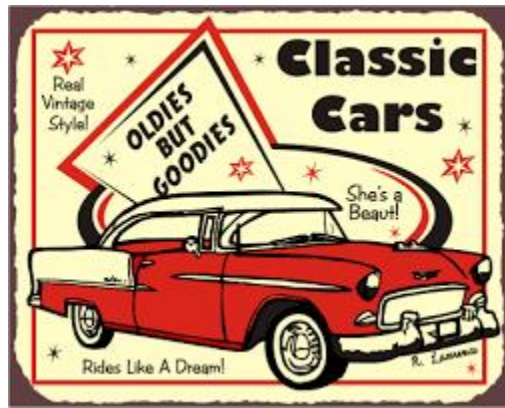
Day Trip to Bayfield Apple Festival: October 6, 2017

The Festival has been hailed as one of the %10 Best Fall Harvest Festivals in the Nation+in 2015 USA TODAY. The annual Apple Festival is a celebration of the autumn harvest and Bayfield's agricultural heritage. We will be seeing fine art exhibitors featuring pottery, paintings, glassworks, photography, wood crafts and fiber arts, listening to the Big Top Chautauqua's Blue Canvas Orchestra, and touring the 15 local orchards and farms, many with pick-your-own apples and pumpkins.

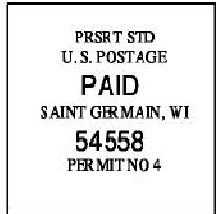
